The aims of the group are to:

1. Bring together key external stakeholders to work together to provide strategic direction and external endorsement for the NE DWMP;
2. Provide support feedback and expert opinion on the development of the DWMP;
3. Provide a clear direction on how best to make the DWMP align with other partners priorities.

## NATIONAL PICTURE

The ODA and the task and finish group met with wider stakeholders on 31 March to share current thinking and learning from other programmes of work. This group included representatives from Ofwat, Environment Agency and ADEPT.

A Cycle 1 to Cycle 2 review group has also been established with specific outcomes of:

- Proposing modifications to the DWMP Framework capturing the lessons learned from Cycle 1 to enhance the process prior to Cycle 2
- Highlighting proposed enhancements to Governments (via the DWMPSPG) prior to their drafting of guidance for the statutory Cycle 2 delivery
- To identify a potential programme of Joint research areas for the coming five-year period where there may be a need for joint research

## OPTION DEVELOPMENT & APPRAISAL

We have been finalising the approach to Option Development & Appraisal which is our next DWMP key milestone. The outputs from the BRAVA and problem characterisation provide an indication of the planning approach to be taken that is appropriate to the complexity and scale of the risk identified.
