UPDATE SINCE LAST NEWSLETTER

We are excited to be starting Phase 1 of our customer research in July forming an on line community, where customers will have opportunity to co create the way the DWMP is shaped for customers use.

We will also be starting our internal stakeholder reviews on the Baseline Risk And Vulnerability Assessments (BRAVA) where internal stakeholders can comment on the BRAVA outcomes in each of the seven strategic planning areas and the risks which are highlighted.
