On 31 May 2023 we published our DWMP on our website. The plan can be viewed at:

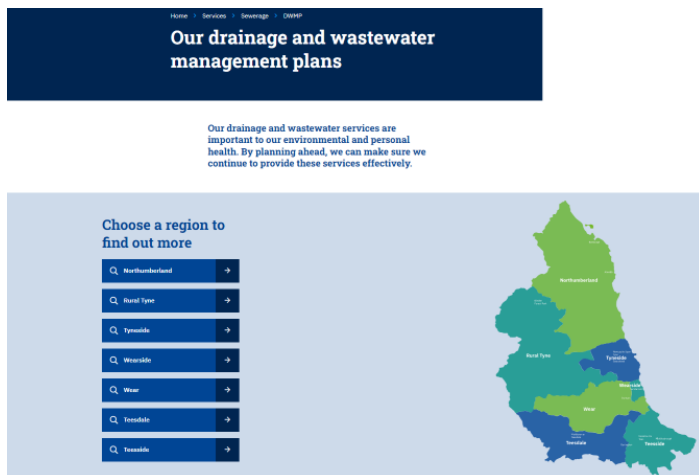
